- Any student with an allergy **must** have written documentation on file.
- We need 2 EpiPens for any child with a prescription
 - Be sure that it is clearly labeled with your child's name and note the expiration date.
 - We will need a medical authorization form filled out and signed by a parent.
- A child that has an allergy requiring an EpiPen prescription will be sat away from children eating the known allergen with spacing as far as possible.
- A classroom teacher will be assigned to supervise a child with severe allergies during mealtimes.
- Parents must provide all food served to any child with an EpiPen prescription on file for a food allergy.
- Parents will be required to fill out an allergic reaction plan form to have on file at school.
